

WHY IS ENDOWMENT IMPORTANT?

- The funds are controlled by the local Council Board of Directors.
- The principal can never be used - only the interest income generated.
- This helps support the maintenance and, if needed, replacement of program features related to Engelstad Scout Park.
- It is a chance to leave a legacy that lasts a lifetime.

EAGLE SCOUTS

- 6% of Scouts attain the Eagle Scout Rank.
- Each Eagle Scout project takes an average of 156 hours to complete.
- 180 astronauts were Scouts; of those, 40 are Eagle Scouts.
- Since 1969 there have been 2,500 Distinguished Eagle Scouts, 8 of those in the Las Vegas Area Council. Jeff Shaw was awarded with the Distinguished Eagle in 2015.

Honor, recognize, memorialize or pay tribute to Parents, Eagle Scouts, Scout Leaders, Individuals, Units, Sponsoring Organizations, Companies or Friends, through the purchase of an engraved paver on the Jeff and Cynthia Shaw Eagle Scout Plaza.

These pavers are a permanent part of the plaza located at the entrance to Engelstad Scout Park, and bring recognition to those who are named. The pavers which are available in three different sizes, create a visually artistic display.

All gifts \$1,000 or more will be recognized as a James E. West Fellow in addition to the paver at the Jeff and Cynthia Shaw Eagle Scout Plaza.

The Engelstad Scout Park, adjacent to the Donald W. Reynolds Scouting Resource Center, opened in the summer of 2018. In addition to serving the needs of 3,700 Scouts and volunteer leaders, the Park is a resource for the entire community. The Engelstad Scout Park features 70,000 square feet of grass, restroom facilities, 6 covered shade shelters, 2 climbing wall pads and walking and hiking paths.
