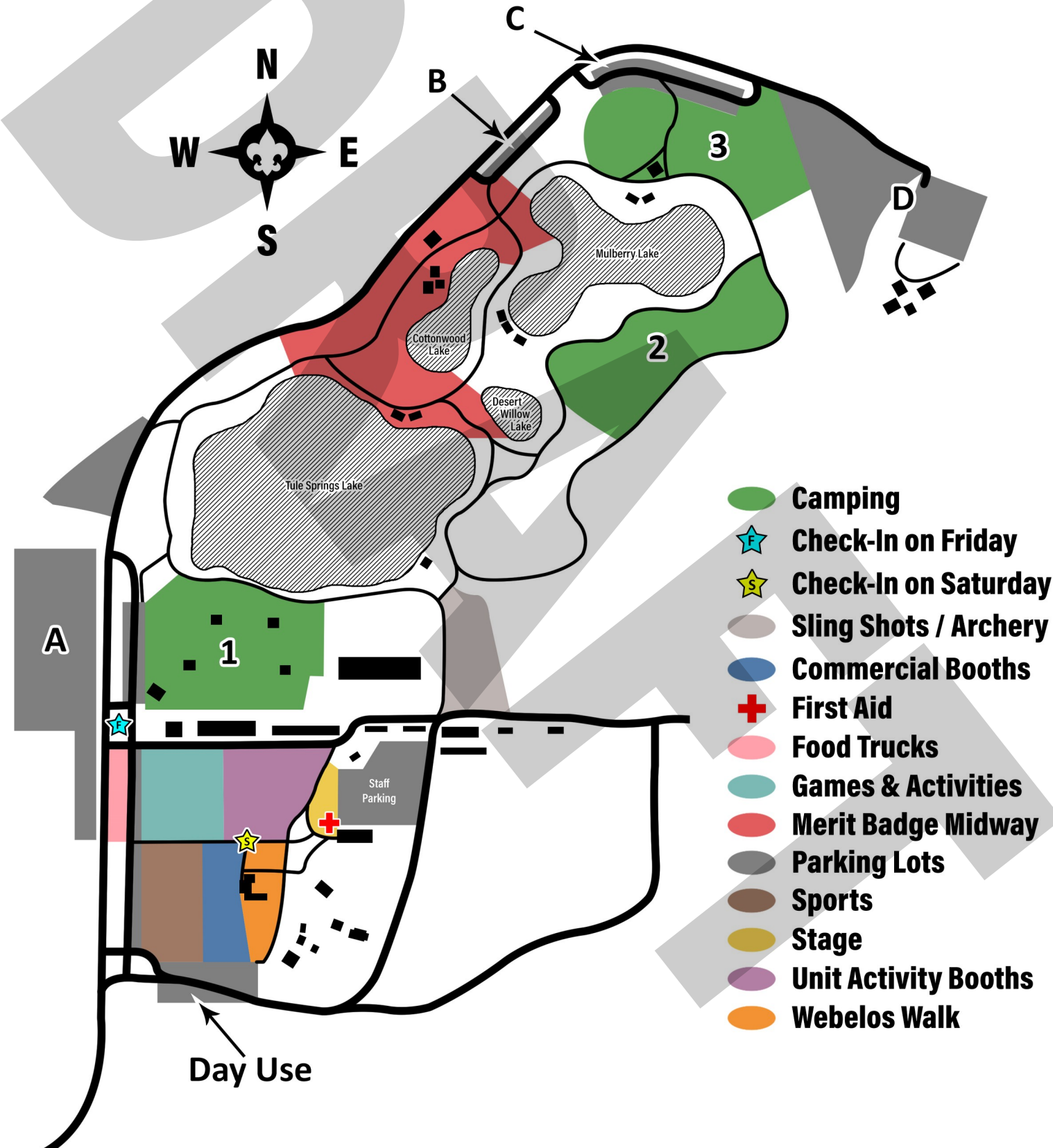

Service Project Opportunity

On Sunday at 8:30am Scouts will gather at the Gazebo for a clean up service project to help Floyd Lamb Park. If your unit is interested in participating, please register your unit at the Leaders meeting on Friday evening or by emailing Eileen.B@scouting.org.

Trading Post-LVAC

The LVAC Trading Post will be open on Saturday from 9:00am – 4:00pm near the Gazebo. Come pick up all your Las Vegas Area Council items and don’t forget about our \$5 grab bags.

T-Shirt Pre-Orders

Pre-Order your 2024 Scout Expo T-Shirt when you register to attend Expo. Those who pre-ordered t-shirts can pick them up at check in Friday evening or on Saturday starting at 9:00am at the gazebo. We will distribute all t-shirts for your unit to the designated Unit Leader at check in. A limited amount of shirts will be available for purchase at the LVAC Trading Post Expo booth at the event.

Webelos-AOL Walk

Webelos-AOL Walk will be taking place behind the Gazebo. Scouts should go directly to their class, there is no need to check in at the Webelos-AOL Walk table. Attendance will be taken at the beginning of class. Most classes are full prior to the start of the weekend. Changes to classes will be handled at the white tent behind the Gazebo.

Activity Booths & Passports

On Saturday from 9:00am - 4:00pm Scouts can participate in free activities such as: games, archery, and Unit booth activities. At check-in scouts will receive a passport, once it is completed, they can stop by the Gazebo to enter into a drawing for free family 4-packs of various shows around town.

Camp Sites

For 2024, we will be **camping by districts**. Within each district, packs and troops will be split into separate areas. See Map in this guide. Units will receive their camp site assignment prior to Expo. Campsites will be assigned by unit size.

Please abide by the following policies:

- Please do not switch campsites.
- No picnic tables, trash cans, **water** or other amenities are provided in the campsites. Bring what you need
- Trash dumpsters will be available in the parking lots.
- No open fires are to take place in campsites.
- All stoves must be kept off the ground.
- Charcoal is only allowed in park provided barbeques.
- Tent space is very limited plan accordingly when making tent assignments.
- **Tent Stakes are not allowed according to Park rules. Bring heavy items to hold down your tents.**

Camping Check-In & Arrival

Check-in will begin at 3:00pm on Friday, October 18, 2024. **Please do not arrive early.** Check-in tent will remain open till 8:00pm on Friday. The park locks the gates at 10:00pm. Saturday check-in will start at 8:30am at the Gazebo.

At check-in you need the following items:

- Send only the 1 designated unit leader from your unit to check in at the tent. This is the person who will be onsite and responsible for medical forms for your unit. All others can go directly to the campsite.
- Total number of attendees for your unit. This includes everyone camping and day use for your unit.
- Verify what day and time your unit will be checking out.
- Turn in your “Medical Form Unit Verification Report”. <https://bit.ly/mfuvr>
 - All A & B Medical forms for your unit will be kept with a designated unit leader, who must be present the entire time your unit is at Scout Expo *including Sunday*.
 - A-B Medical forms are required for ALL participants regardless of age. <https://bit.ly/abmedforms>

You will receive the following at check-in:

- Maps, schedules, verify campsite assignment, passports, wristbands and patches for camping and day use & any pre-ordered t-shirts for your unit.
- Depending on your campsite location, you may be directed to another parking lot.

Please keep driving in the park to a minimum.

Camp Site Competitions

Here is your Units time to show off what you have. Setup a gateway, decorations, or mock campfire. All structures must be less than 8ft off the ground. Saturday afternoon sites will be judged and awards presented at the Saturday evening Campfire program. We can't wait to see how you incorporate your units decade into your decorations.

Cancellation / Refund Policy

All Fees for this event are non-refundable but can be transferred to another person in your unit at this event.

Check-Out

When your unit is ready to check-out, please make sure all trash is taken to the dumpster in the parking lots. Remember to leave the area better than you found it.

Day Use Check-In

Day use check-in will take place at the information Gazebo located in the vendor area from 8:30am - 2:00pm. **If more than one family is registered for Day Use for a unit, one registered unit leader will receive all items for those attending for the day. It will be their responsibility to distribute to everyone in their unit.** You will receive the following at check-in: maps, schedule, passports, wristbands, patches & any pre-ordered T-shirts.

Leaders Meeting-Friday Evening

Friday evening immediately following the opening show we will hold a brief leaders meeting at the stage. Please have at least one leader from you unit attend this meeting for any last minute information.

Merit Badge Midway

Merit Badge classes are located around the lake. Scouts should go directly to their class, there is no need to check in at the Merit Badge booth. Attendance will be taken at the beginning of class. Most classes are full prior to the start of the weekend. Changes and class registration will be handled at the white tent near the restrooms. Independent merit badge paperwork must be dropped off before 9:00am at the merit badge tent and wont be ready for pickup before Monday at 8:30am at the Council Office.

Parking Fees-Waived

Tell the guard at the gate you are with Scout Expo to avoid parking charges.
